### **Question 2**

As a candidate, you are running to replace Layne Baraldi or Howard Vipperman. Why do one or both of these CC members need to be replaced?

### **Question 3**

The city of La Habra Heights is facing some budget challenges. As a City Council member, what policies or changes would you support to correct the problem?

### **Question 4**

Describe/explain your recommendation on how the city should run the fire department.

### **Question 5**

What role, if any, should volunteerism play in the city?

### **Question 6**

As a City council member, how would you help to maintain and/or strengthen our rural environment?

### **Question 7**

As a city council member, how would you govern homeowner disputes as they relate to the General Plan and the city codes?

### **Question 8**

What is your vision for the city of La Habra Heights over the next 10 years?
